







Queensland University Musical Society

Children's Worship Bulletins


Activity sheets based on the lectionary are now available each week so please ask the door duty officer if you need one.

Andy's Place

Everything is now in place for Andy's Place to function with registration of the new charity having been received. Andy's Place is under the governance of the Uniting Church Property Trust through the Saint Andrew's Church Council. We have a Management Committee comprising Susan Pickering (chairperson), Jenet Niven (Coordinator/Secretary), Robyn Lulham and Ralph Collins (Church council representatives) and Rex Niven (Treasurer). We have our first management meeting next week and will be looking at having an official launch of the newly badged charity soon. At this time there are two main existing activities now managed by Andy's Place – [1] The Community Meal and [2] Andy's Place Shop and we will be investigating how we might expand our services to the homeless and disadvantaged in the city.

Importantly, Andy's Place has obtained tax deductibility and all donations over \$2 can be claimed as a tax deduction. **Donations in support of the Andy's Place programmes can be made to BSB 114 879 A/C 497 923 539** and I will issue tax receipts at request if you send advise to me at treasurer@andysplace.org.au. **Note that donations for the Community Meal should be sent directly to Andy's Place as above and not to the existing church bank account.**





Christmas Gift Bags

We are continuing the Saint Andrew's tradition of providing a Christmas Gift Bag to our Community Meal guests at the meal closest to Christmas Day. We plan to provide a selection of items as last year. There will be a tin of biscuits, homemade Christmas cakes and cooking, chocolates, sweets, Christmas mince tarts, toiletries and other small items depending on what is available.
