Community Outreach – Social Justice Table

The Social Justice Table returns this Sunday - 3 April 2022!

Come along after church and purchase some tasty fare and help support a local group, the Brisbane Domestic Violence Service – BDVS.

In January, the ABC reported that the domestic and family violence crisis had escalated during the COVID pandemic, as the pandemic had created 'perfect conditions' for abusers.



The Chief Executive of Full Stop Australia, which

offers support, education and training for victims of domestic and family violence commented that "the pandemic [provided] the perfect conditions for perpetrators of violence and abuse in the home because they pretty much had the person they were abusing there 24/7, who was unable to get support, and [they] could monitor them all the time".

Research shows that last year more than one in five women experienced emotionally abusive and controlling behaviour from their live-in partners, as many domestic violence victims were forced to cohabit with perpetrators and experienced more surveillance and monitoring. Nearly half, 43 per cent, of the domestic violence workers said abusers used the pandemic environment to control victims by making threats to the safety of women and their children.

Last year, the Social Justice table dedicated its March fundraising to the Hannah Clark Foundation after the tragic murder of Hannah and her 3 children by her estranged partner at Camp Hill in February 2020. This year we have decided to support another local group, BDVS – the Brisbane Domestic Violence Service- offering services, support and advocacy for those experiencing domestic and family violence. It operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is an outreach of Micah Projects.
