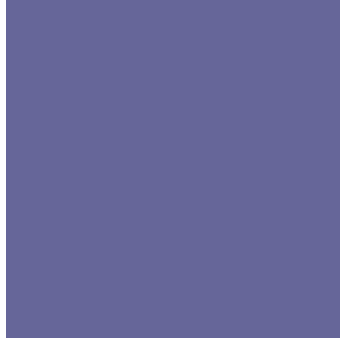
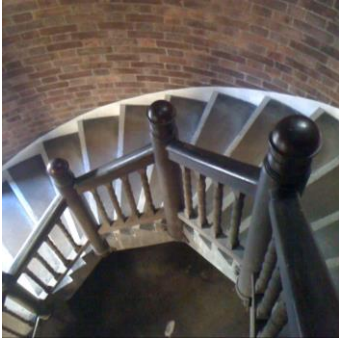

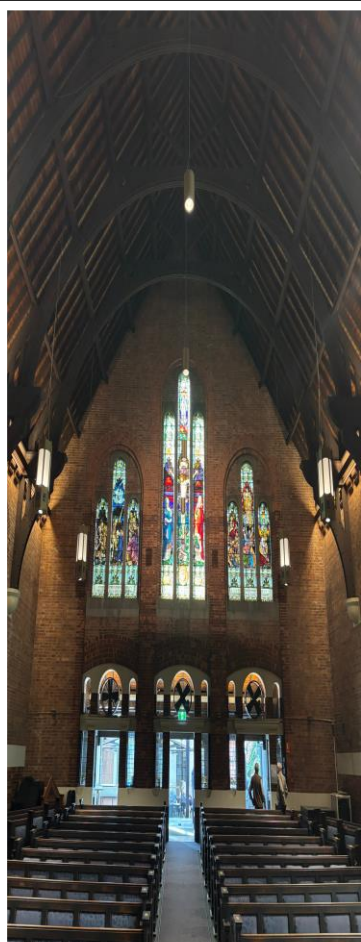
### **WINE AND SPIRIT BOTTLES!**
