



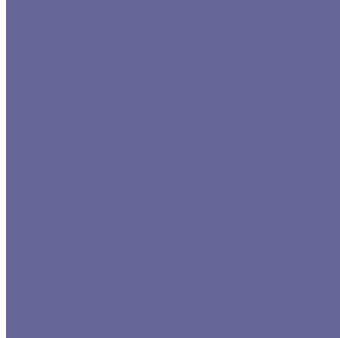


Help the Environment and Recycle your containers. No C10161825. **NOW ACCEPTING**
