



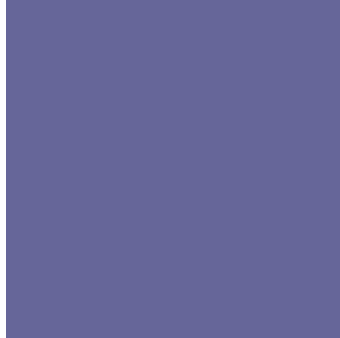
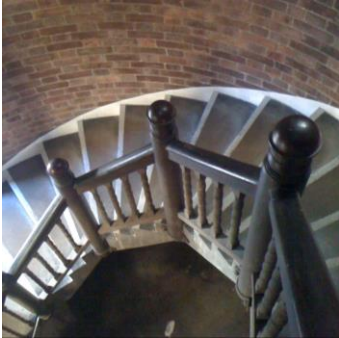

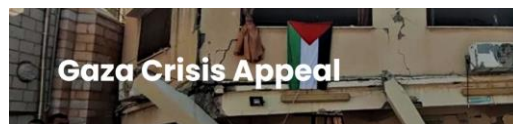
Pray for continuing cessation of hostilities in Sudan and the earthquake victims in Afghanistan.

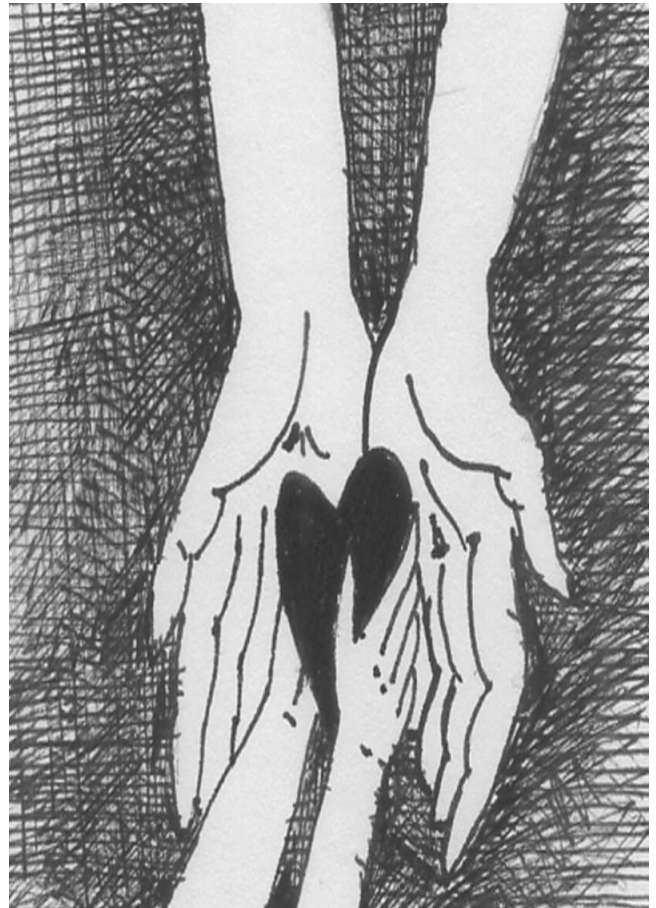
