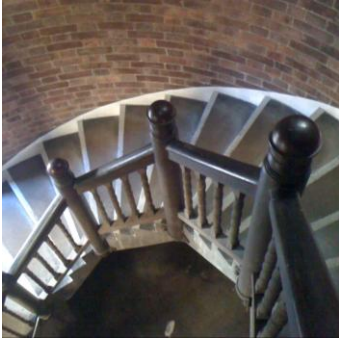

### **Wishing Matthew well..**

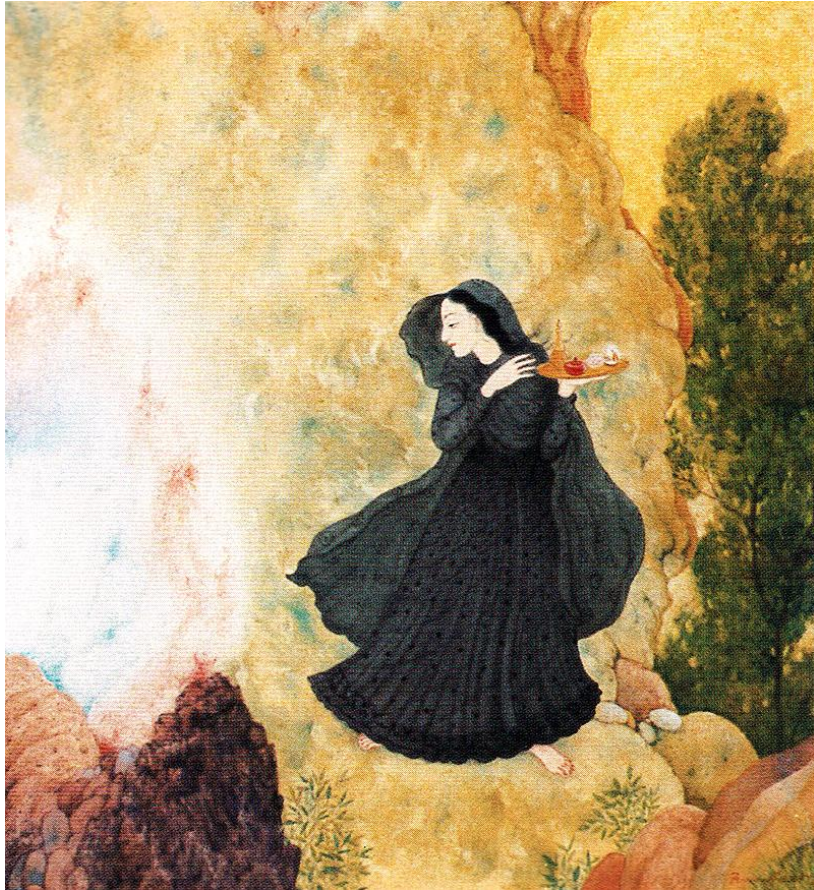
