



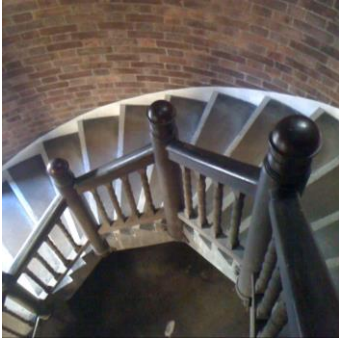

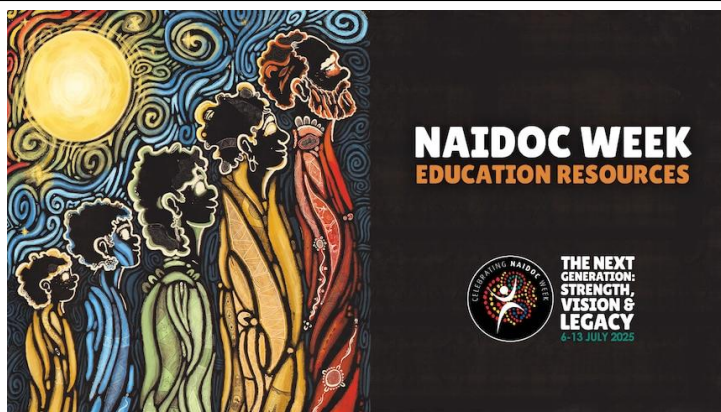

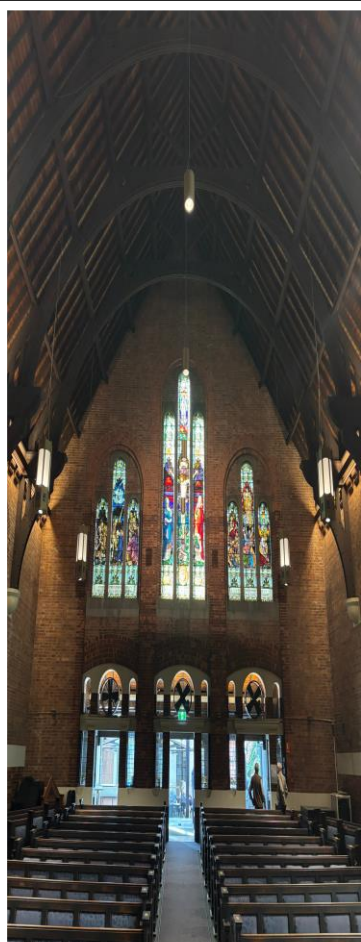
WINE AND SPIRIT BOTTLES!

Luckily we had 14 students and 3 teachers from Lismore helping us. The students were great - very enthusiastic and took direction well.

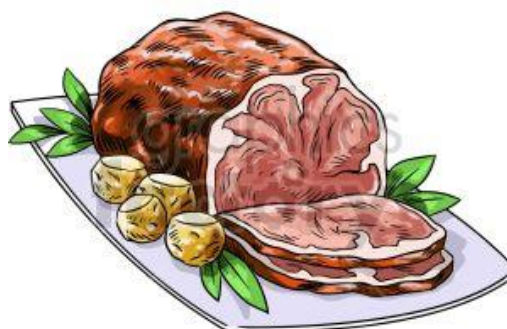
